# CRMS Library News

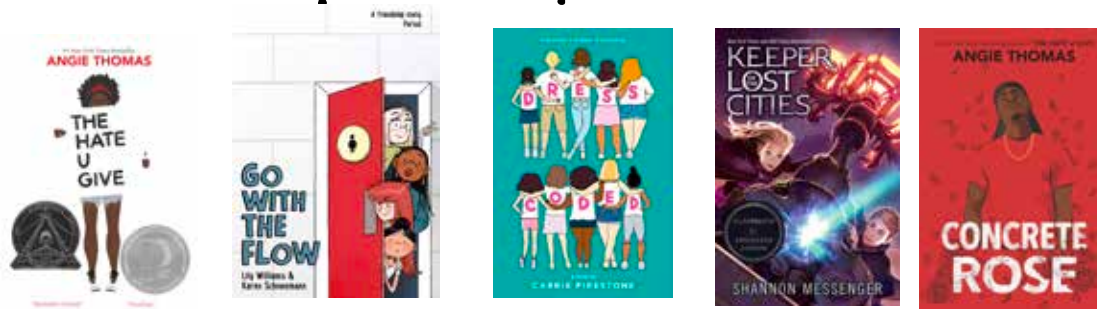
We are nearing the end! The end of the year means library inventory, and library inventory means we have to have all the books back on the shelves!
